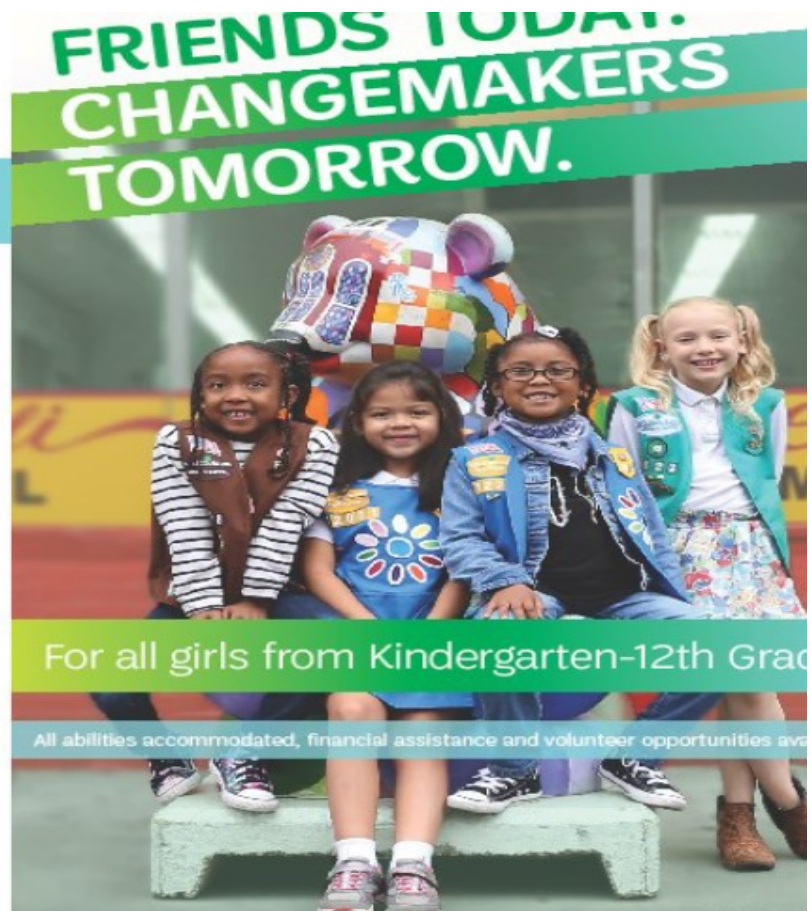
As for girls in K-5 we have a four session program that focuses on STEM, sisterhood, life skills, space and the outdoors, all while having fun.

## **COVID-19 VACCINES IN FAIRFAX COUNTY ANNOUNCEMENT:**

Beginning on Monday, January 11, (not before) **people age 75 and older** can call the Fairfax County Health Department **703-324-7404** to schedule an appointment for a COVID-19 vaccine.

The phone line hours are Monday – Friday, 9:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m. and weekends 9:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. Phone wait times may be lengthy and it is recommended for the comfort of callers, to place their phones on speaker function as they wait to be connected.
