Re: COVID-19 – Update #9

As part of our COVID-19 communications, we are including updated information on vaccine availability. While the wait times remain long, you now can preregister for the Coronavirus vaccine. Details are provided below.

Who is eligible? City of Alexandria **residents who are 65 years of age and older, individuals who are 16 through 64 years with a high risk medical condition** or disability that increases their risk, and/or individuals who are members of an eligible workforce group. Eligible workers include: **Police, Fire and Hazmat, Correction and Homeless Shelter Staff, Childcare/PreK-12 Teachers & Staff, Grocery Store Workers, Food and Agriculture Manufacturing, Public Transit Workers, and Mail Carriers.**

Demand for the vaccine is high. If you have internet access, you should register for an appointment through **Vaccinate.Virginia.gov**. If you do not have internet access, call the Vaccinate Virginia hotline at **(877) 829-4682** to register for an appointment.

For your safety and the safety of those around you, we are providing 2-ply face masks for everyone in your household. Please remember to wear a 2-ply face mask when in shared spaces (hallways, laundry rooms, etc.) and continue to practice social distancing.
