**Vaccines** are available for the following groups of people:

### People aged 65 and older

People 16-64 with underlying medical conditions

Health Care Workers, Police, Fire & Hazmat

Childcare/K-12 Teachers/Staff (public & private)

Grocery store workers and Public transit workers, Mail carriers
