## > Who is currently eligible; am I?



**Beginning Jan. 25<sup>th</sup>**, individuals eligible to register and receive the vaccine include:

### People aged 65 and older

Health Care Workers

Police, Fire & Hazmat

Childcare/K-12 Teachers/Staff (public & private)

## > What can I do?
