Re: COVID-19 – Update #9

As part of our COVID-19 communications, we are including updated information on vaccine availability. While the wait times remain long, you now can preregister for the Coronavirus vaccine. Details are provided below.

Who is eligible? 1) Adults 65+ who live in Fairfax County, the cities of Fairfax or Falls Church, or the towns of Herndon, Vienna or Clifton; 2) people ages 16-64 with a high-risk medical condition or disability that increases their risk of severe illness from COVID-19 who live in Fairfax County, the cities of Fairfax or Falls Church, or the towns of Herndon, Vienna or Clifton; 3) people living in correctional facilities, homeless shelters and migrant labor camps

In addition, the following **Frontline Essential Worker Priority Groups** who live or work in Fairfax County, the cities of Fairfax or Falls Church, or the towns of Herndon, Vienna or Clifton: 1) Police, fire and hazmat (Frontline Essential Worker Group Priority #1); 2) Corrections and homeless shelter workers (Frontline Essential Worker Group Priority #2); 3) Childcare/K-12 Teachers/Staff (Frontline Essential Worker Group Priority #3), including staff serving public and private schools; licensed center-based childcare staff and licensed home-based childcare staff.

Demand for the vaccine is high. If you have internet access, you should register for an appointment through the County's website at: <https://www.fairfaxcounty.gov/health/novel-coronavirus/vaccine/registration>. If you do not have internet access, call the Fairfax County Health Department at 703-324-7404 to make an appointment.

For your safety and the safety of those around you, we are providing 2-ply face masks for everyone in your household. Please remember to wear a 2-ply face mask when in shared spaces (hallways, laundry rooms, etc.) and continue to practice social distancing.
