As part of our COVID-19 communications, we are including updated information on vaccine availability. While the wait times remain long, you now can preregister for the Coronavirus vaccine. Details are provided below.

Who is eligible? District residents who are **65 years of age and older** and/or individuals who are members of an eligible workforce group. Eligible workers include: **individuals who work in a health care setting; individuals who work in a grocery store setting; outreach workers who work in health, human, and social services; individuals who work in manufacturing; and individuals who work in food packaging.**

Demand for the vaccine is high. If you have internet access, you should register for an appointment through [vaccinate.dc.gov](http://vaccinate.dc.gov). If you do not have internet access, call the District's hotline at **855-363-0333** to register for an appointment.

For your safety and the safety of those around you, we are providing 2-ply face masks for everyone in your household. Please remember to wear a 2 ply face masks when in shared spaces (hallways, laundry rooms, etc.) and continue to practice social distancing.
